Task 4: Education and Outreach

• The TWRI PM completed 3 workshops. Two of the workshops, the ones on 8/23 & 30/17 were held at the San Benito Wetlands site and were planting workshops that consisted of the PM giving the participants a general description of the project and how it has an impact on water quality as well as providing 10 new acres of wetland habitat. Then he described the tree planting activity and broke everyone into 2-3 person planting teams. There were 15 participants at the 1st workshop and 32 participants at the 2nd workshop.

The presentation on 8/27/17 was hosted by the city of San Benito Chamber of Commerce at their "Coffee with" meeting. "Coffee with" is monthly meeting hosted by the Chamber of Commerce that brings together the city commission and members of the community to discuss a different issue, concerns and city projects with a local expert or volunteer every month. The meeting was well attended with approximately 20 people there. Some of the distinguished attendees were, the new Mayor, 3 city commission members and 1 Cameron County Constable. There were also members of the local news-papers in attendance and that resulted in an article being written about the project and was ran in the Valley Morning Star on September 28, 2017. The renovation of the pole barn as abandoned after UTRGV Civil Engineering students conducted a forensic investigation into the barn and deemed it not suitable for renovation and recommended demolition of the structure before it collapses. Instead, the city and PM decided to have local volunteer groups design and paint homemade interpretative signage in lieu of the pole barn; 2 of the local signs have been completed but only one has been installed due to heavy rain. The PM will work with the city to install an additional 5 local signs at the project site when weather permits. The PM has also purchased professional interpretative signage from iZone Imaging to be installed at the project site; 2-24"x 36" signs about the birds/wetlands and 5 plant identification signs. The PM is working with Keep San Benito Beautiful, South TX Master Naturalist and Master Gardeners volunteers on the content of the signs. The design of the signs are still about 1 month away due to the enormous amount of content that this site has. An ongoing bird count/bird list for the project site dating back to 2012 lists 146 bird species at the ponds with the potential of attracting 250. The professional signs will be installed by the end of the year. The PM will continue to work to install all signs in order to complete this deliverable as part of his
